


## **MAKING A BABY**

7	One of the ways for a sperm and an egg to meet is by people having sex.  Grown-ups have sex in lots of different ways to show how much they care about each other, even when they are not trying to make a baby. When two grown-ups have agreed to make a baby by having sex, they kiss and cuddle until the penis becomes hard.
	The illustration on this page depicts a cartoonish man and woman laying on a bed. The woman is underneath the man. They are kissing.  The illustration on the bottom left side of the page depicts a cross-section of an erect penis inside a vagina. The male and female reproductive organs are shown. See Figure 3
8	Teeny-tiny sperm travel from the testicles through the penis, and into the vagina.
9	One way that scientists can help people to make babies without having sex is by putting sperm directly into the womb of the person who is going to grow the babyFirst, sperm is collected. This could be from a parent-to-be, or it could be from someone who gives away their sperm to help other people make babies.

	Sometimes a baby can't be looked after by their birth family, so they are taken care of, or adopted,

	Some babies' bodies are a bit like a boy and a bit like a girl. These babies are intersex. Some people grow up feeling that the biological sex they were given at birth is not their true sex, or that they don't belong to either sex. And some help the way they look on the outside match up with the way they feel on the inside.




